
CHECKLIST - NEW DEVELOPMENT OR EXPANSION

Section 19 of the Cremation, Interment and Funeral Services Regulation

Before an operator of a place of interment interments human remains or cremated remains in an area of the place of interment that is not included in plans provided to the director under section 18 (a) and (e) for that place of interment, the operator must

- a) submit to the director plans of the type referred to in section 18 (a) and (e) for that proposed area of interment, and
- b) obtain the approval of the director for interring human remains and cremating remains in this area.

Section 18 of the Cremation, Interment and Funeral Services Regulation

Requires a licensee to submit the following to the Director, Consumer Protection BC:

- a) a map that shows
 - i. each proposed area for interment in relation to the other areas of the place of interment;
 - ii. every lot, fence, walk, road, watercourse or building in the place of interment and the dimensions of each;
 - iii. the total area of the lots and the total area of the land in the place of interment, and
 - iv. descriptive names and numbers for each proposed area of interment
- e) a detailed plan for the future care and maintenance of the property including:
 - i. the manner in which the applicant proposes to fund the care and maintenance of the place of interment, and
 - ii. the manner the applicant intends to keep monies for the care and maintenance of the place of interment separate from all other monies of the applicant

In addition, to the above specified in 18 (a) & (e), the following documents must be provided

1. aerial photo (internet accessible photos will be accepted)
2. current copy of the cemetery bylaws
3. the type and dimensions of each interment lot. Including, but not limited to graves, niches and crypts.
4. the number of interments for each lot
5. the type of interment of each lot (human/cremated remains)
6. the price list for each type of interment
7. the amount of the contribution to the care fund for each right of interment and/or memorial
8. a current land title document showing PID and confirming Certificate of Public Interest on title (cemetery notation).
