Checklist

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

To become a licensed Home Inspector, all required documents listed in this checklist must be submitted with your application, as missing items may delay processing beyond the estimated four-week timeframe.

Step 1: Complete Your Education

Expect to spend at least 150 hours to learn about topics such as roofing, flashing, chimneys, heating and cooling, plumbing, electrical and structural systems and more. You must complete your education through one of the approved home inspector programs:

Complete 50 hours of home inspection under an approved trainer, logging only the time spent on-site inspecting residential properties and reasonable time spent report writing, excluding driving, planning, and post-inspection activities; submit this log with your application.

Step 4: Provide A Peer Recommendation Letter

After completing a home inspection with a Consumer Protection BC-approved evaluator, secure a letter of recommendation reflecting your knowledge and skills demonstrated during the inspection and in your report.
